



making a budget

A profit is the money you make once you have paid for all of the expenses for your business. Look how Penny sold 12 cups of lemonade for \$1 each and spent \$5 on expenses. She made a profit of \$7 that she can now spend, save, or do a little of both.



Income \$12

MINUS



Expenses

\$5

EQUALS

Profit \$7

for every 12 cups of lemonade sold

Help Penny decide what to do with her profits. Today she sold 36 cups of lemonade.
